- Munro in various contexts: regional, national, generational
- Reception across cultures and languages; global Munro
- Translation and stylistic studies of Munro's short fiction
- Interdisciplinary and innovative literary-critical approaches
- Munro's stories in the classroom

The language of contributions is English. Papers should be between 5,000 and 8,000 words in length, with an abstract of about 150 words. They should **conform to the author guidelines** available here, and **should be submitted via the ELOPE platform** available here.
