International Interdisciplinary 3rd Congress of the Centre for Interdisciplinary Research of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Osijek: "Society, Sciences, and Arts in the (Post)Digital Era" will take place on November 8–10, 2023, and is organized by the Centre for Interdisciplinary Research of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Osijek, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Osijek, and Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Center for Scientific Work in Vinkovci.

Two forms of congress participation: physical, in the Small Conference Hall of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences (Hall 39), and remote, via the Zoom platform. This year's INTER_CON opens the possibility of presenting knowledge to the interested public to all those who:

- 1. research the (post)digital era in an interdisciplinary fashion;
- 2. research complex problems of (post)digital society, sciences, and arts in an interdisciplinary way;
- 3. create new models for facing challenges caused by the (post)digital in society, sciences, and arts;
- 4. approach their scientific and artistic practice guided by the principle of social responsibility.



The suggested thematic frameworks by no means exhaust research possibilities and approaches to dealing with the theme of the congress.

Experts (both theoreticians and practicians) from all fields of science and arts are welcome to participate in the Congress. Additionally, students of all levels of study can participate in the Congress. There are four ways of participating: oral presentation, art exhibit, art performance, and poster.

The deadline for submitting abstracts is September 25, 2023. The official languages of the Congress are Croatian and English. Participation fee is 70 euros (VAT included). If participation in one paper is submitted by several authors, the first author pays the registration fee in full, the second author pays 50 euros, while the third and each subsequent author pays the 30 euros (VAT included). Students of all study levels are exempt from paying the registration fee.

All Congress participants will be informed in a timely manner of details regarding the realization of the Congress. Besides that, all participants will be encouraged to send their papers proceeding from their participation in the Congress, in either of the two official languages: Croatian and English. Instructions to authors and other information related to publishing a paper in the upcoming Book of Proceedings will be delivered alongside the Call for Papers after the Congress takes place.
