Summer School Bovec 2025

The Summer School Bovec is a two-week educational experience taking place in the town of Bovec, located in Slovenia in the Soča Valley, the heart of the Alps-Adriatic region.

Participants will have the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of one of the languages of the Alps-Adriatic region (German, Italian, Slovenian, Croatian or Friulian) but also to experience multilingualism and intercultural dialogue first-hand. The Summer School's innovative format also promotes an understanding of the historical, social and economic contexts that characterize the Alps-Adriatic region.

Each year, the Summer School adopts a central theme, exploring it through a **transcultural, interdisciplinary and multilingual approach**. Participants have the opportunity to:

- **Attend an Intensive Language Course** in: German, Italian, Slovenian, Croatian or Friulian;
- Deepen their knowledge of the General Topic by engaging in **Scientific Lectures** and **Workshops** led by experts;
- Gain exciting insights into the history and rich cultural and natural heritage of the region during **Cultural Excursions**;
- Build up an **International Network** in the Alps-Adriatic region.

Upon successful completion, participants will be awarded **3 ECTS credit points**.
