


Join us in celebrating Mario Brdar's Distinguished Career

Mario stands for ... Mentor, Metonymy, Multimodality

The Department of English Language and Literature at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Osijek takes great pleasure to invite you to the colloquium dedicated to

Professor Mario Brdar, member of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts

who has shaped the minds of countless students during his 40-year tenure with us and who has created a unique network of colleagues and researchers in the field of Cognitive Linguistics.



The colloquium organised on occasion of Mario's retirement is envisioned as a meeting point of his mentees, colleagues and friends who would contribute with their talks to thematic panels focused on topics close to Mario's heart: metonymy, metaphor and Cognitive Linguistics in general.

Thematic panels would have a more or less free form with 15 minute talks followed by in-depth discussions among a smaller group of experts, which would, hopefully, foster future collaborative research and enable deeper understanding of specific sub-topics:

15 minute talk



3 panels:

- Metonymy and metaphor in a review mirror - reflections on metonymy and metaphor research, from the beginning towards their current status in CL
- Figurative language, literature, grammar and multimodality a look at the interplay of figurative language, grammar, culture, literature and imagery
- Guided by...- presentation of research supervised by Mario and where it lead us



These three panels would be organised in three sessions whose structure would depend on the proposals of talks to be submitted (in English) by 15 June 2025 at the latest.

You'll be notified about the tentative program proposal by 30 June.

We find that this focused and intimate setting allows for a more detailed exploration of the subject matter and is ideal for exploring complex issues that cross traditional academic boundaries.
